

First, are you in the right folder? `git remote -v`

SANDBOX sandbox-yourusername not graded

Before each class: get my new notes

```
git checkout main
git fetch upstream
git merge upstream/main
```

Conflict in one of my files?

Take my version and move on:

```
git checkout upstream/main -- <that file>
```

Work through the lecture notebooks and You Trys here.

1. Catch your branch up (do this first)

```
git checkout main
git pull origin main
git checkout your_branch_name
git merge main
```

2. Work in this week's folder

Week01 to Week05

3. Save and share

```
git add Week03
git commit -m "what you did"
git push -u origin your_branch_name
```

whichever week it is

4. On GitHub

Open a Pull Request into main. A teammate reviews and merges. Do not delete your branch.

Last step, on Canvas: a short individual reflection. What you did, what you learned, what was hard.

Git refuses to merge, pull, or switch branches? It is protecting unsaved work. Commit first, then try again:

```
git add -A git commit -m "save my work"
```

Git asks about rebase? We never rebase in this class. Run this once and it stops asking: `git config --global pull.rebase false`

Cannot push to main? That is on purpose. Get on your branch: `git checkout your_branch_name`

Stuck for 15 minutes? Ask. Do not lose an hour to it, and do not let it stall your team.
